



## **TEACH THE TEACHER GREEN CONSULTANT COURSE (TtT) FOR THE NORDIC COUNTRIES**

### **Green Consulting TEACHtheTEACHER (TtT) Course Description/Syllabus**

The Green Consulting TtT-course provides participants with the knowledge and methodological competency to develop and update a sustainable curriculum/strategy for universities, media related institutions and companies in the transition to sustainable film and media productions.

#### **Learning Objectives:**

- Understand the theoretical and legal foundations of sustainability and environmental management systems.
- Implement sustainable practices in film and media production, including green film production and sustainable project management.
- Identify and address hotspots in production processes, such as energy consumption, transportation, materials, and waste management.
- Develop a curriculum/sustainable strategy in the respective operational scenario (to be defined)
- Design a concept (with draft) for a standard criteria catalogue for sustainable media productions.

#### **Workload:**

The Green Consultant TtT course corresponds to 6 credit points of the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) with approx. 180 h workload over the course time, variable depending on individual previous knowledge. The further training consists of two modules with a final presentation and certification.

#### **Module A: ONLINE SESSIONS**

##### **Sustainability Fundamentals/Green Producing**

- Theoretical and legal foundations of sustainability. Overview of relevant laws, regulations, and standards related to environmental sustainability in the film and media industry
- Understanding of Environmental management and reporting systems (ISO 14001/EMAS/ESRS/CSRD)
- Green film production basics and sustainable project management
- Hotspots in production processes: energy, transportation, materials, and waste
- Project planning/management with the Green Sustainable Canvas
- CO<sub>2</sub>e Calculator: Overview of various CO<sub>2</sub>e calculator tools and their use in measuring and reducing the "carbon footprint" of film and media productions
- Reporting Standards for a media production

##### **Module B: ON SITE Case Study/Certification**

- Overview of the objectives and requirements for the sustainable curriculum/strategies
- Develop a curriculum/sustainable strategy in the respective operational scenario (to be defined-basis of the certification )
- Sketch of a concept/draft for a standard criteria catalogue for sustainable media productions (optional).
- Supervision and evaluation of the sustainable curriculum/strategy by the instructors, with feedback and guidance provided to participants throughout the process.
